TEAM INFORMATION

First preference is given to teams that were entered the previous year and in good standing. Teams must return their application with a \$100 deposit by *FRIDAY July 27, 2018*

METHOD OF SELECTION

After teams from the previous year have had their chance to reapply, the method and priority of acceptance of new teams will be: *FIRST*—those Alameda sponsored teams having at least 50 percent Alameda residents; *SECOND*—those teams with 75 percent of their players who are Alameda residents; thereafter, all other applicants as may be necessary to complete leagues. *A minimum of 12 and a maximum of 20 persons is required on the official team roster.*

League play will begin August 20, 2018 at Lower Washington Park

HOW MUCH IS THE ENTRY FEE FOR THE WOMENS SOFTBALL SLO-PITCH LEAGUES?

10-Game Season:\$670	Resident Team
\$721	Non-Resident Team
12-Game Season:\$773	Resident Team*
\$824	Non-Resident Team*

Resident Team consists of 75 percent or more players who live in Alameda. Non-Resident Team consists of 74 percent or less players who live in Alameda.

WHAT DOES THE ENTRY FEE PAY FOR?

Monies collected are used to pay for game balls, bases, lights, light replacement, umpires and league administration.

WHEN ARE ENTRY FEES AND ROSTERS DUE?

Once you have been officially accepted, the balance of your team entry fee will be due no later than *MONDAY*, *August 20, 2018 IN THE ARPD OFFICE*. Your *REMAINING BALANCE* will be (less \$100 deposit):

10-Game Season: \$670 less \$100 deposit = **\$570 Resident Team**

\$721 less \$100 deposit = **\$621 Non-Resident Team**

12-Game Season: \$773 less \$100 deposit = **\$673 Resident Team**

\$824 less \$100 deposit = **\$724 Non-Resident Team**

Completed team rosters must be turned in at the first game.

FAILURE TO PAY LEAGUE FEES BY MONDAY, August 20,2018 WILL RESULT IN YOUR TEAM BEING DROPPED FROM THE SCHEDULE.

TEAM PLACEMENT

Team placement will be at the discretion of the League Coordinator.

CLASSIFICATION OF LEAGUES
