- Meet Neighbors as we beautify the neighborhood!

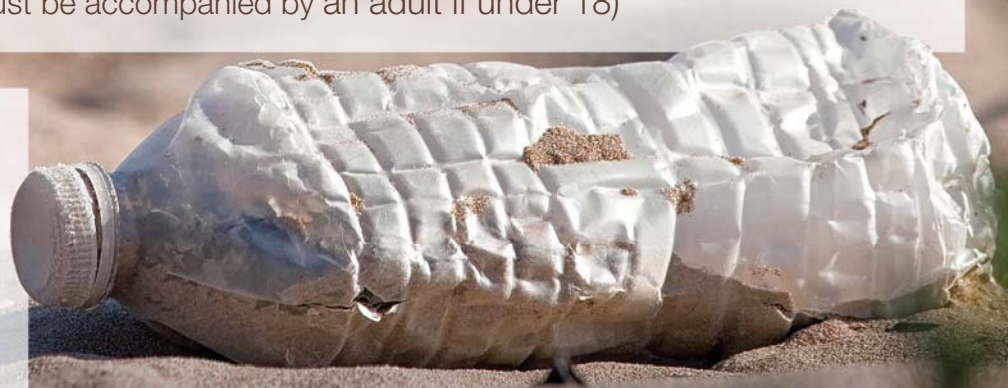
