The Encinal Boat Launch Facility is well-utilized by the community and has deteriorated over the years due to use and weather. The design and planning is funded by a grant through the California Department of Parks and Recreation, Division of Boating and Waterways.

Redesign includes:

- Replacing the existing dock float and adding a dock for non-motorized watercraft.

- Adding a fish cleaning station and parking lot lighting.
