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PROJECT LOCATION



This Project is part of the City's larger Cross Alameda Trail (CAT) project, a premiere crosstown, bicycling and walking corridor that when complete will connect the west side of the island to the east, from the former Naval Air Base to the Miller-Sweeney (Fruitvale) Bridge.

The CAT is being constructed in segments. The CAT/RAMP + Gap segment, running parallel to and south of Ralph Appezzato Municipal Parkway, between Main Street and Constitution Way is approximately 0.9 miles in length, and is composed of two subsegments:

1. Ralph Appezzato Memorial Parkway (Main Street to Webster Street)

2. Atlantic Avenue (Webster Street to Constitution Way)



1. Ralph Appezzato Memorial Parkway (Main Street to Webster Street; 'CAT / RAMP')

Construction of walking and bicycling paths, plus a jogging path, in the City-owned abandoned railroad right-of-way. Approximately 70 foot wide right-of-way, immediately to the south of Appezzato Parkway, adjacent to apartment complexes, schools, several businesses and a Boys and Girls Club. This segment includes the following additional features:

- a) Connector trails to intersecting streets; Fifth Street and West Campus Drive,
- b) Pedestrian, bicycle, and ADA improvements, w/ signage at intersecting streets,
- c) Hardscaped, landscaped plazas at each end; Main Street and Webster Street,
- d) Trees, shrubs, bioretention and self-retaining areas, w/ landscaping and urban runoff control, and
- e) Traffic signal modifications at Fifth Street, Webster St., and Constitution Way,

Note: This segment includes significant earthwork in the excavation (relocation and 'capping') of contaminated soils, creating the subgrade for the bicycle and pedestrian paths, with the placement of a soil cap over the majority of the site.

2. Atlantic Avenue (Webster Street to Constitution Way; 'Gap')

Construction of two-way bicycle lanes on the south side of this short urban block, one half of which will be at sidewalk-grade (west of business parking lot driveway), and the other at street-grade (east of this driveway). This CAT section includes improvements to the two intersections, the busiest in the City, to facilitate safe pedestrian and bicycle crossings. Project includes signal modifications, plus installation of a mid-block crossing with a flashing beacon, and the creation of a new bus stop platform.

- b) Alameda CTC Countywide Discretionary Grant (sales tax and vehicle registration fees),
- c) Transportation Development Act, Article 3,

- e) Transportation Fund for Clean Air (TFCA) Bikeways Fund (BAAQMD).
